



FACTS WHAT DOES SANTANDER CONSUMER USA INC. DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why? Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What? The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and income
- Account balances and payment history
- Credit history and credit scores

How? All financial companies need to share customers’ personal information to run their everyday businesses. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers’ personal information; the reasons Santander Consumer USA Inc. chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do

How does Santander Consumer USA Inc. protect my personal information?

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards, secured files and buildings and limited access to your information by employees.

How does Santander Consumer USA Inc. collect my personal information?

We collect your personal information, for example, when you:

- Apply for financing or pay your bills
- Give us your contact information or provide employment information
- Give us your income information

We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates and other companies.

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only:

- Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness
- Affiliates from using your information to market to you
- Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.

What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?

Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.

Definitions

Affiliates

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *Our affiliates include companies with a Santander name; financial companies such as Banco Santander.*

Nonaffiliates

Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *Santander does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.*

Joint Marketing

A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

- *Our joint marketing partners include warranty or service contract providers, GAP insurance providers and other insurance companies.*

Other important information

Vermont Residents. If you are a resident of the state of Vermont, the following notice applies to you. For joint marketing with other financial companies, we share limited information about you as follows: name, contact information, and our own transaction and experience information.
